



YOUNG AT ART 2018

Dear Young Artist,

Thank you for your interest in the **“Young at Art” show to be held at the New London Historical Society on Sunday, May 20, 2018 from 1:00 to 4:00 pm.** The show is open to all students from kindergarteners to seniors in high school from the towns of Newport, Sunapee, Sutton, New London, Warner, Bradford, Wilmot, Grantham, Croydon, Newbury, and Andover.

This year there WILL NOT BE A PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FORM! Instead the entry form will be filled out digitally at the same time that you drop off your artwork. Below is a sample entry form so you will know the information required at the artwork drop off.

Each artist may submit ONE (1) piece of artwork. The categories are:

- **DRAWING:** pencil, charcoal, pastel, pen & ink, crayon, and/or markers
- **PAINTING:** watercolor, acrylic, oil, tempera
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** any type
- **THREE DIMENSIONAL WORK:** sculpture, jewelry, painted/decorated boxes, etc.
- **HISTORICAL:** this can be any media as long as it is in some way inspired by an object (or building or event) in one of the region’s historical societies/collections. The NLHS will gladly coordinate bringing an object from our hands-on collection to an art class if the teacher contacts us and sets it up. Otherwise, artists are encouraged to make appointments with their historical societies. *This category purposely leaves LOTS of room for interpretation!*

All artwork **MUST** be **SIGNED** and **MATTED** and/or **FRAMED (or attached to a larger piece of poster board or construction paper)** and **READY TO HANG**. Any artwork that is not ready to hang will not be displayed. This rule will be strictly enforced.

There is no need to spend a lot of money for a frame. Inexpensive frames can be found in craft stores and resale shops. Matted art should be wrapped in plastic for protection and have some sort of tab on the back for hanging.

ART DROP-OFF: *in the NLHS Phillips Barn, 179 Little Sunapee Rd, New London NH)*

Individual Drop Off (for parents/guardians/artists dropping off their own artworks): Friday, May 18th 3:00pm-6:00pm

Local artists will judge the entries. Cash prizes will be awarded for First, Second and Third Place in each age group category: Primary (K-2); Intermediate/Elementary (3-5); Middle (6-8) and Secondary (9-12). Winning entries will be exhibited at the Tracy Memorial Library for one week following the art show. **All other pieces of art must be picked up between 4:00 and 4:30pm on Sunday, May 20** (immediately after the awards ceremony).

You and your family are invited to join us at the Historical Society for refreshments and the opportunity to view all the entries. **The awards ceremony will be in the Meeting House at the New London Historical Society at 3:30 pm on Sunday, May 20, 2018.**
